

From drug to doping – the GLP-1 story

GLP-1 receptor agonists (GLP-1 RA) have become a standard in modern diabetes and obesity disease management, with impressive glucose and weight-lowering efficacy as well as benefits on other measures cardio-renal-metabolic health.

However, the clinical evidence resulting in a rising trend in GLP-1 RA utilization with a potential for misuse and counterfeits.

Apart from the widespread use of GLP-1 RA for cosmetic weight loss purposes, GLP-1 RA appears to be increasingly used to improve performance in competitive (and potentially also recreational) athletes. This seminar will give an overview on the development and current state of research and clinical use of GLP-1 RA. In addition, the potential of these drugs in competitive sports will be discussed, touching on the regulatory and legal framework, and emphasizing the complex analytical challenges in the detection of GLP-1 RA.
